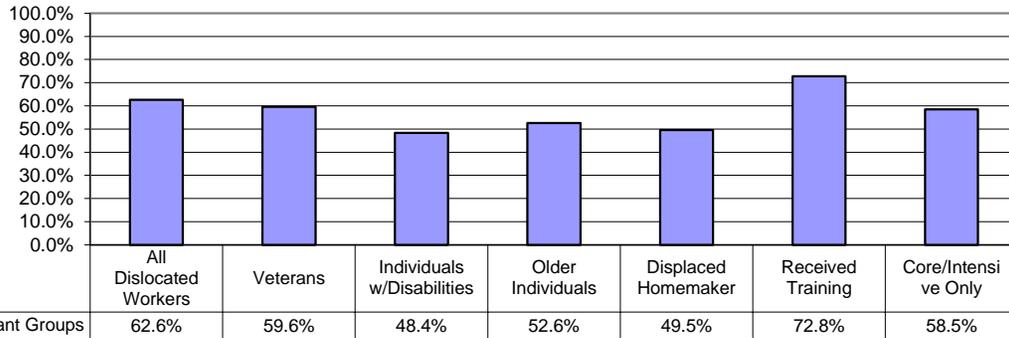

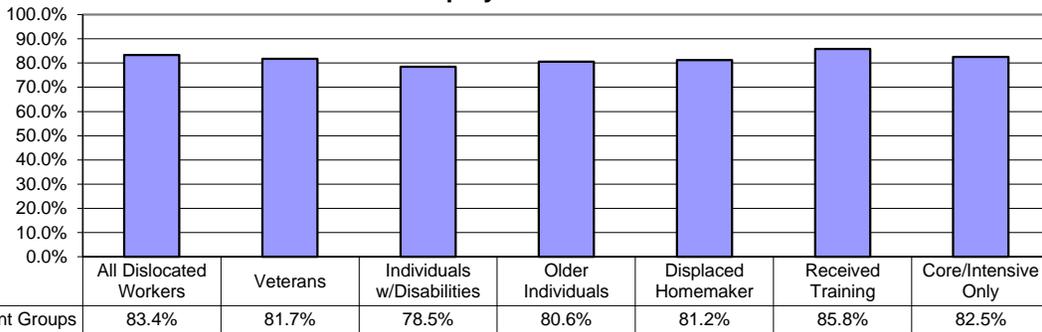

Dislocated Worker Average Earnings**

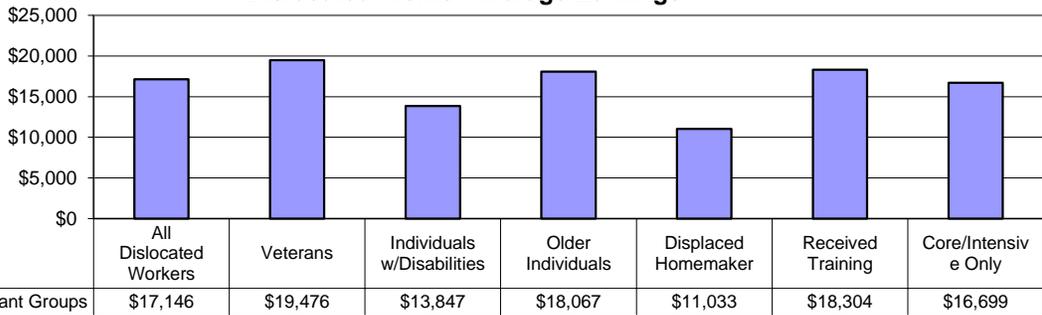
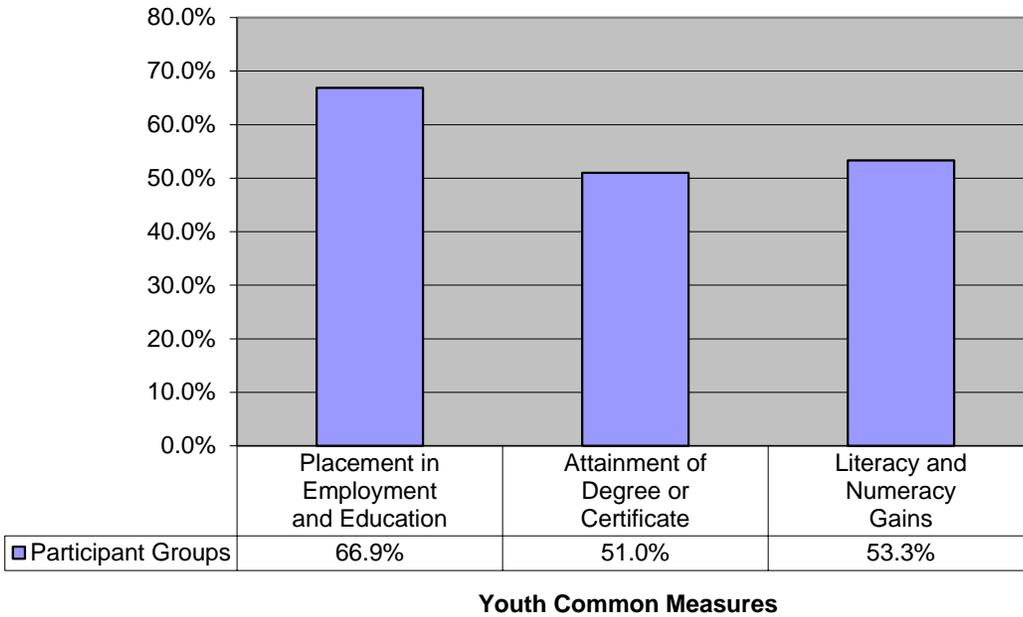
