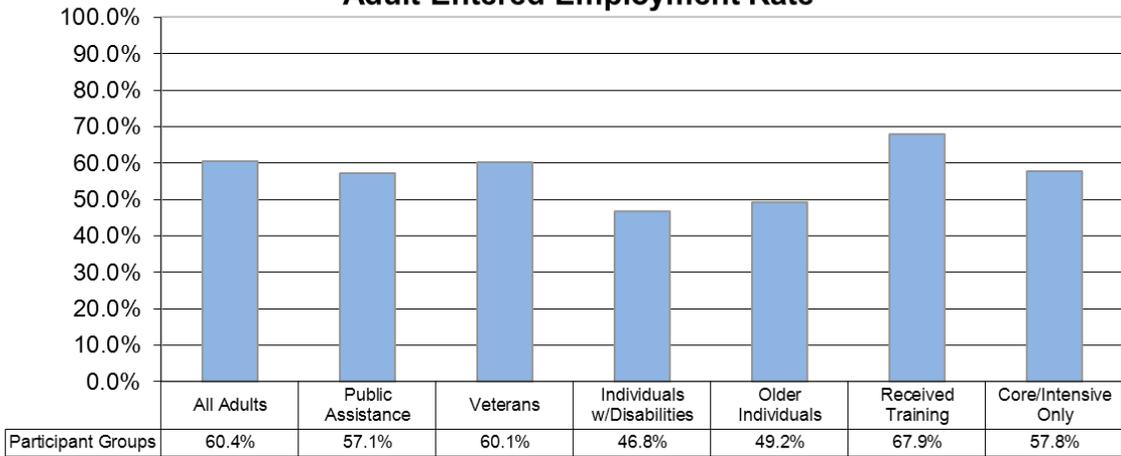

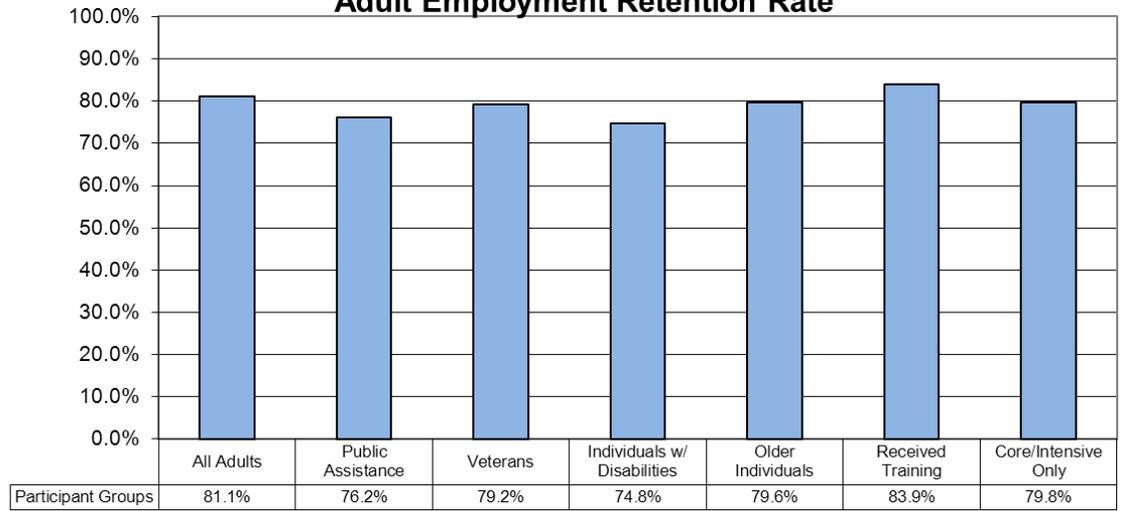

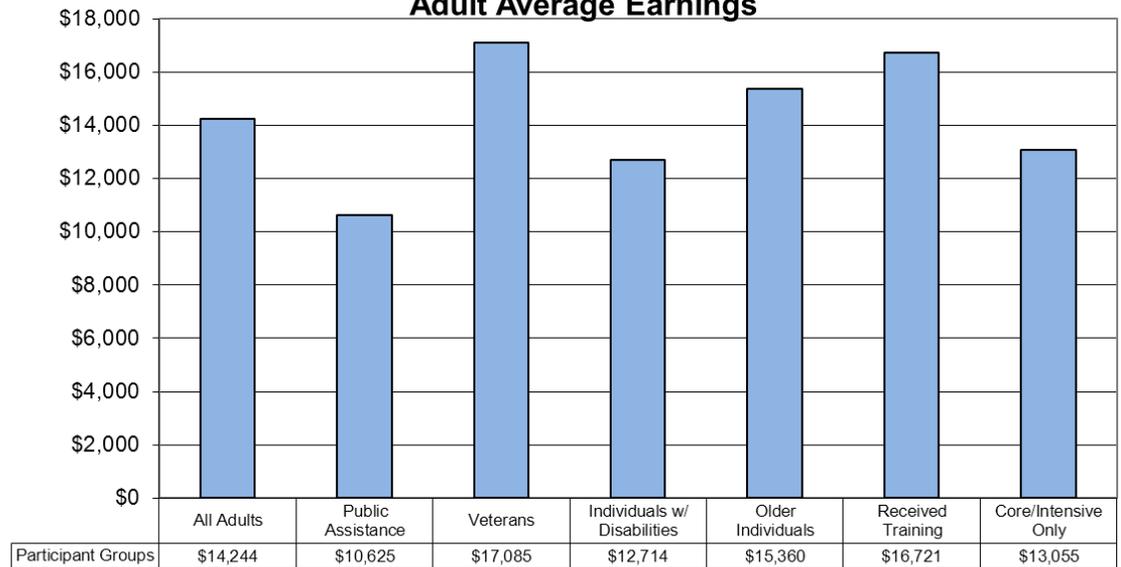
**Figure 1

Adult Average Earnings**



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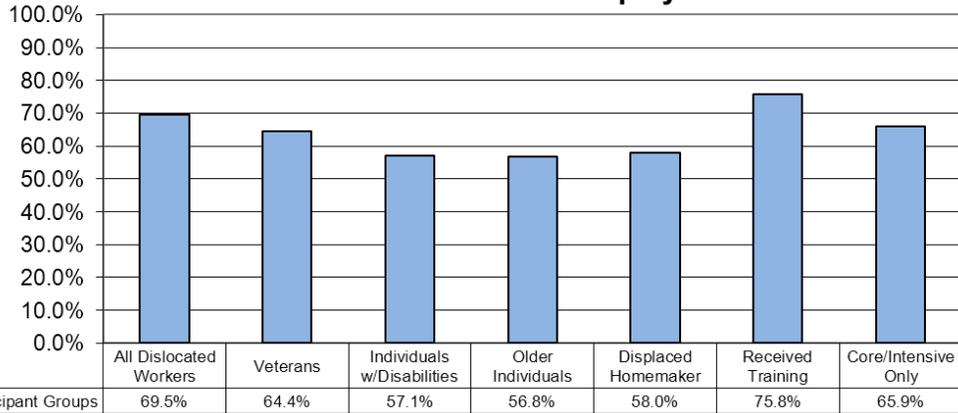

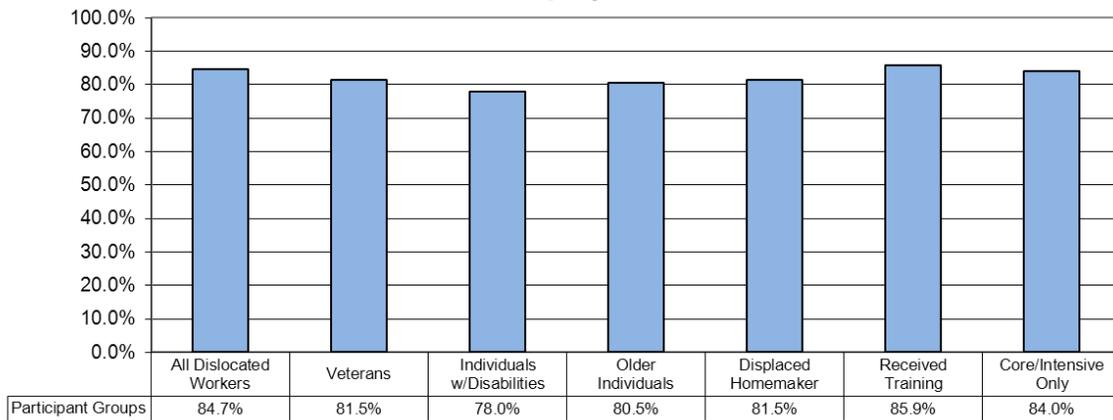

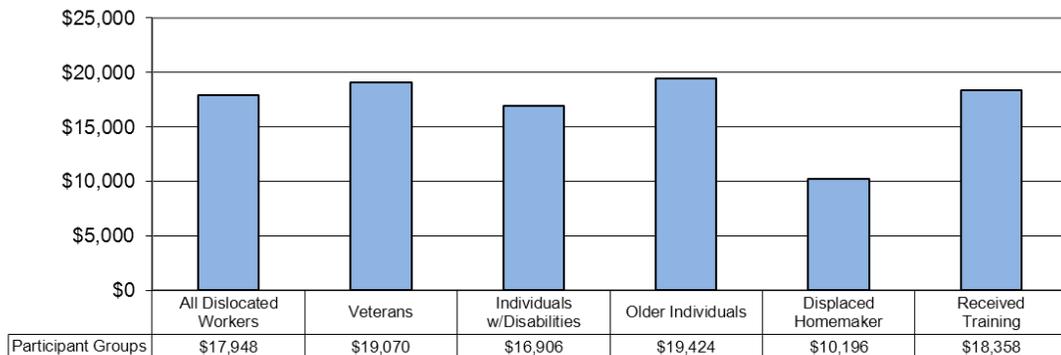

Dislocated Worker Employment Retention Rate**



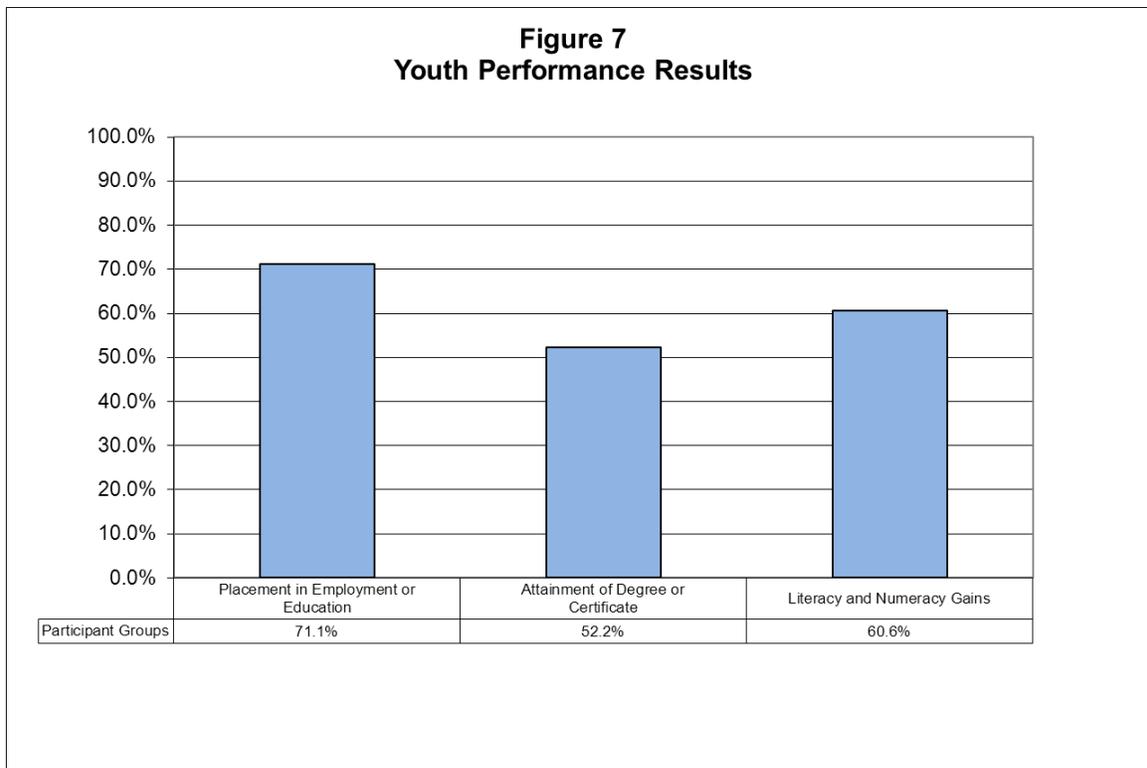
