

**CA General Statistics:**

- ❖ 1<sup>st</sup> in size of state deficit
- ❖ 4<sup>th</sup> in unemployment (9.3%)
- ❖ 4<sup>th</sup> in foreclosures
- ❖ 1<sup>st</sup> in stimulus funding for highways
- ❖ 2<sup>nd</sup> in stimulus funding for Medicaid

**What's in the ARRA for a green CA?<sup>2</sup>**

- ❖ 11B for Smart Grid – CA gets ~10% for energy transmission
- ❖ Federal buildings to be more energy efficient
- ❖ 5 B for weatherization – CA gets ~10%
- ❖ 2 B for renewable energy grants
- ❖ Tax credits for energy efficiency experiments
- ❖ Loan guarantees
