16. Description

Pursuant to 24 CFR 115, FHAP contributions agencies may be funded under multiple categories through annual Cooperative Agreements. This Agreement provides funding to DFEH under the following categories, in the amounts indicated, for work performed during the periods noted therein:

(1) Complaint Processing (CP) Funds: reimburses DFEH for complaints it completed the processing of between July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, as follows:

- 665 cases receiving full or partial payment, excluding cause cases, totaling \$1,278,109;
- 22 cases sent to counsel for issuance of a cause finding, totaling \$75,600;

Therein all totaling for CP: \$1,353,709.

(2) Administrative Costs (AC) Funds: reimburses DFEH for authorized expenses as described in the "FY2012 Funding Guidance for FHAP Contributions Agencies", pursuant to a formula set forth therein. Agencies processing 100+ complaints receive 20% of prior year's Cooperative Agreement total not including Partnership Initiative Funds. Agencies processing <100 cases receive AC funding pursuant to formula within "FY2012 Guidance to Agencies" (attached). Funding is conditional upon a written statement from DFEH setting forth how the funds were utilized for purposes authorized in the FY 2012 Guidance to Agencies.


AC funding for DFEH based upon 685 total cases processed. \$2,298,267 x .20 = \$459,653.

(3) Training Funds: reimburses DFEH for NFHTA and/or other HUD-authorized training activities undertaken by it between October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012, pursuant to criteria set forth under the FY2012 Guidance to Agencies, and pursuant to formula established therein based upon population of area served by agency.

Training funding for DFEH based upon 2010 census of 37,253,696 persons is \$20,000.

Additional considerations: All provisions of the original Memorandum of Understanding between HUD and DFEH, and the 7/16/2009 Addendum to the MOU, remain in effect and are binding. Attachments to which this Cooperative Agreement is also subject, and to which DFEH's signature on this Cooperative Agreement also obligates it, include: (i) FY 2012 Guidance to Contributions Agencies; (ii) FY 2012 Contributions Agreement Schedule of Articles, including Standard Assurances and Administrative Requirements; (iii) FY2012 Attachment A: Criteria for Processing; (iv) FY2012 Attachment B: Standards for Timeliness and Quality.

Total of all three categories is: \$1,353,709 (CP) + \$459,653 (AC) + \$20,000 (Trng) = \$1,833,362.
