

Convert Current Google Site Search (GSS) in URSUS 2007 Template

These instructions will help convert the current GSS code on URSUS production sites to the new features in URSUS for GSS.

Step 1 – Add GSS Account Number

Have your GSS account number available. If you do not know your GSS account number, please contact the service desk and open a work order for Web Services.

- Login to the URSUS authoring site
- Select **Edit My Site**
- Select **Site Settings**
- Enter the GSS account number in the GSS field under Search and Statistics

- Select **Apply Changes**

Step 2 - Remove the Code in Agency Branding

- Select **Edit My Site**
- Select **Go to My Site**
- Under the Edit Content panel, select **Agency Branding**
- Select **HTML** view
- Delete all the GSS code. Make sure not to delete the agency branding image (i.e., ``). The only code on the page after deleting the GSS code will be the agency banner image.

The GSS code starts with this:

- Go back to **Design** view
- **Save** the page

Step 3 – Change Search Page Name


- Go to the **Admin Panel**
- Select **Page List**
- Find the search page called “**Search Results**” file name: “search_results.htm”
- Select **Edit**
- Change the file name from “search_results” to “**serp**”
- Select **Apply Changes**
- Select **View Page**



Step 4 – Publish Entire Site

- Under the **Admin Panel**, select **Publish Entire Site**
- Once the site is published, check the search on production. Make sure there is no error and that the search results are correct. See examples below.
