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This emergency action by the Department of Food and Agriculture expands the quarantine area for the Asian Citrus Psyllid (ACP) *Diaphorina citri* near the Goshen area of Tulare County into the Hanford area of Kings County. This action also incorporates the existing quarantine in the Unincorporated area of Kings County. The amendment provides authority for the state to perform quarantine activities against ACP within this additional area.

OAL approves this emergency regulatory action pursuant to sections 11346.1 and 11349.6 of the Government Code.

This emergency regulatory action is effective on 11/9/2016 and will expire on 5/9/2017. The Certificate of Compliance for this action is due no later than 5/8/2017.


