1. CALL TO ORDER

Lisa Cooley called the meeting to order at 2:07 pm.

2. WELCOME/INTRODUCTIONS

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS

5. APPROVAL OF DECEMBER 2014 MINUTES

6. MEMBER REPORTS

Rick reported that there was nothing new out about the legislation. He brought up the TIME act (Transition to Integrated Meaningful Employment Act.) Rick advised that it is being introduced by the same person that introduced the fair wages act. He is a congressman from Mississippi and has a child with a developmental disability. (Congressman Greg Harper)

Lisa reported she continues to do presentations in the community and is doing one on transition from college to work. She is continuing to put things together for a partnership together with Brian Knirk at American River College.

Robert Taylor reported that the North Coast office had a meeting on February 21, 2015 and discussed the 5 year plan. Robert sits in the Olmstead Advisor Committee, and was accepted back for a 3rd term. He also shared information on videos regarding Olmstead with the SCDD SAAC. At the Council meeting in March Robert ran for Vice Chair but was not elected. Robert shared that he filed a grievance regarding a bus pass issue that arrived late in March 2015 and provided members with a copy of his informal meeting decision.

7. REVIEW OF EFC PACKET

Mary Ellen reviewed the Employment First Committee (EFC) packet with members. Edits needed for the December 2015 EFC meeting minutes were discussed and members plan to address them at tomorrow's meeting.

Nelly explained her role supporting EFC and how she replaced Mark Polit supporting the EFC. Nelly also asked what members think their role is on the EFC.

Members received copies of the finalized Employment First Flyer.
